

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Description: Dining & Counter Table

Important safety instructions:

- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the table.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.

Pre-assembly:


- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

A	Table Top	1
B	Leg Frame -1	1
C	Leg Frame -2	1

Hardware List

Item	Description	QTY
a	Short Bolts $\varnothing 1/4" * 3\frac{3}{4}" L$	4
b	Long Bolts $\varnothing 1/4" * 2" L$	1
c	Lock Washers $\varnothing 1/4"$	4
d	Flat Washers $\varnothing 1/4"$	4
e	Plastic Washer $\varnothing 1/4" * 20mm$	1
f	Allen wrench $1/4"$	1


**Assembly Procedures:**

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Loosely attach the leg frame-1 (C) to the leg frame-2 (B) as shown below. Securely tighten the bolts with Allen wrench (f).

(b)x1 Long Bolts


(e)x1 Plastic Washer

(f)x1 Allen wrench



Step 2. Loosely attach the assembled legs (C, B) to the bottom of table top (A) as shown below.

- (a)x4 Short Bolts 
- (c)x4 Lock Washers 
- (d)x4 Flat Washers 



Step 3.

- 1) Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (f). Turn the assembled counter table to an upright position.
- 2) Assembly is complete. Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
