Important safety instructions:

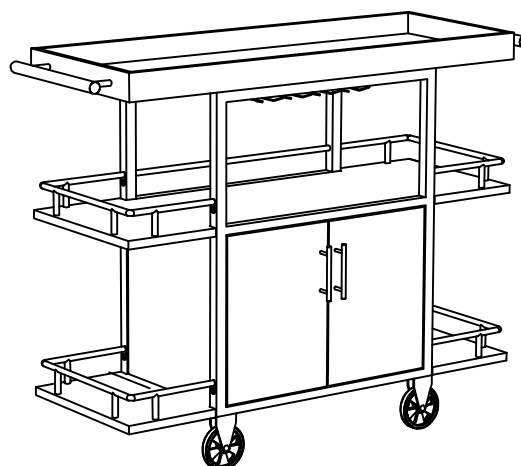
- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the cart.

- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

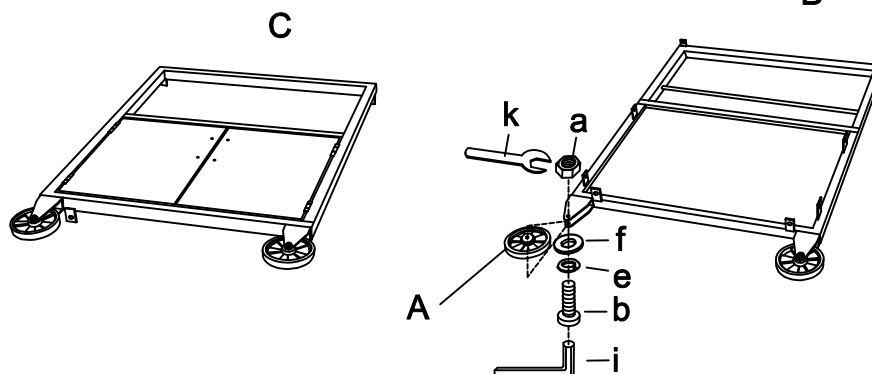

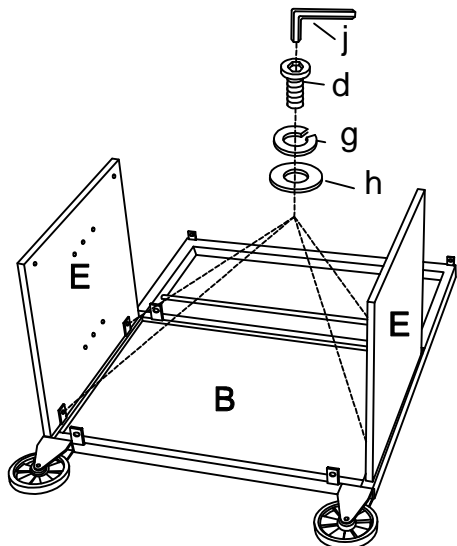
**Assembly Procedures:**

Step 1. Assemble the cart on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish.

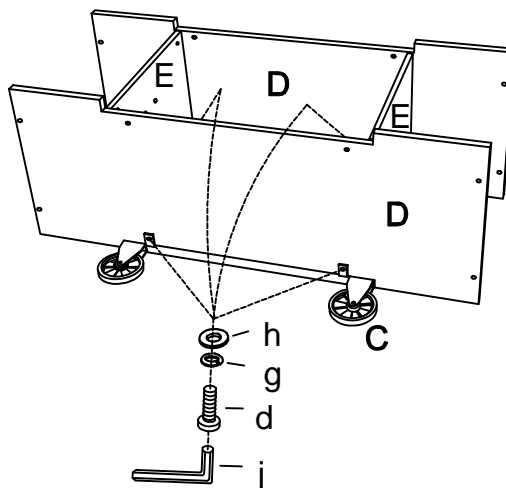
Attach the wheels (A) to the front frame (C) and back frame (B) by using the nuts (a), big bolts (b), big block washers (e) big flat washers (f), big Allen wrench (i) and open wrench (k) as shown.



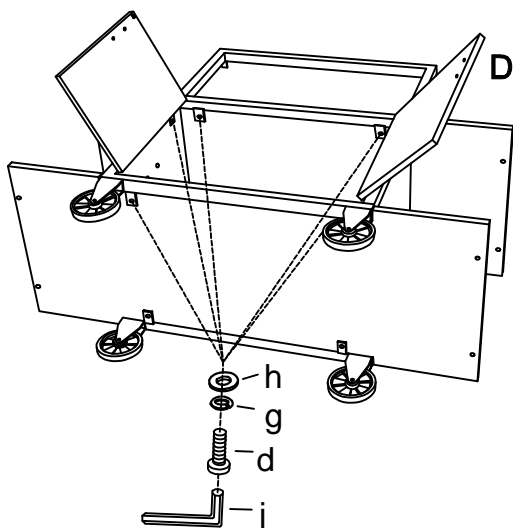
Step 2. Loosely attach the side panels (E) to the back frame (B) by using medium short bolts (d), small flat washers (H), small lock washers (g). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts. .



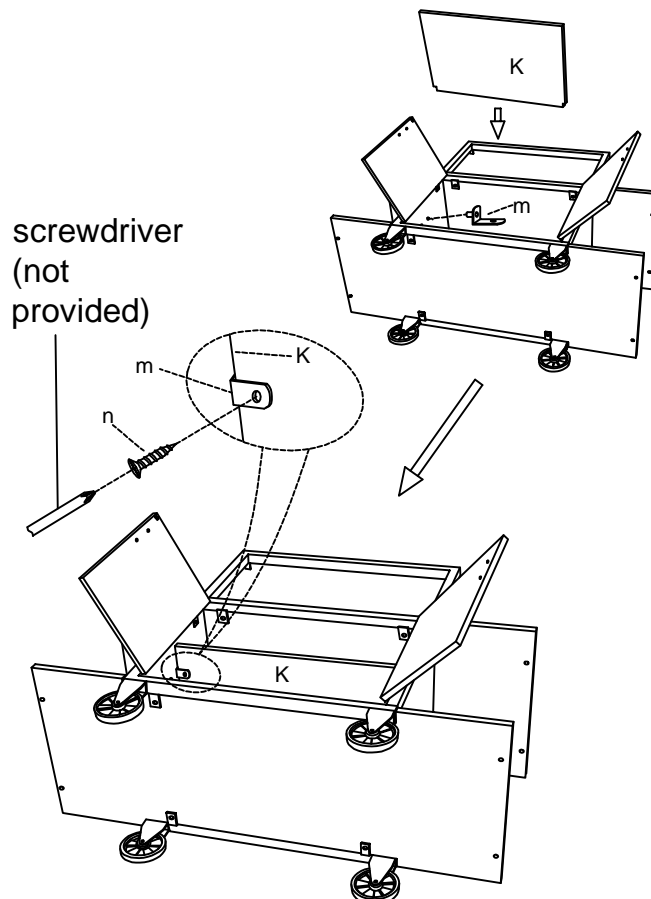
Step 3. Attach each long shelf (D) to the back frame (B) by using medium short bolts (d), small flat washers (H), small lock washers (g). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts. .



Step 4. Open the doors, then attach front frame (C) to the shelves (D) using medium short bolts (d), small flat washers (H), small lock washers (g). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts. .

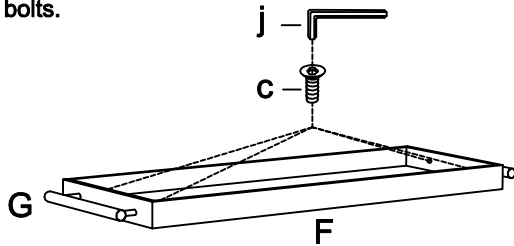


Step 5. Insert the end of shelf support (m) into the holes on the side panels (E), then attach the short shelf (K) to the shelf supports (m) using screws (n). Securely tighten the screws by a screwdriver (not provided).

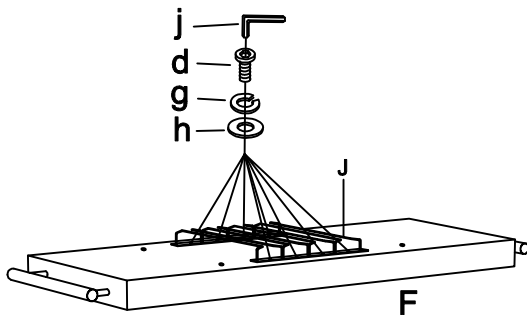


Step 6:

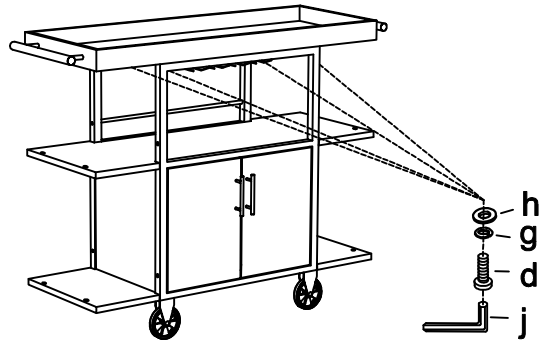
a) Attach the big handles (G) to the side of top tray (F) using medium long bolt (c). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts.



b) Turn the top tray upside down, then attach the glass rack (J) to the bottom of top tray (F) by using medium short bolt (d), small lock washer (g) and small flat washer (h). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts.



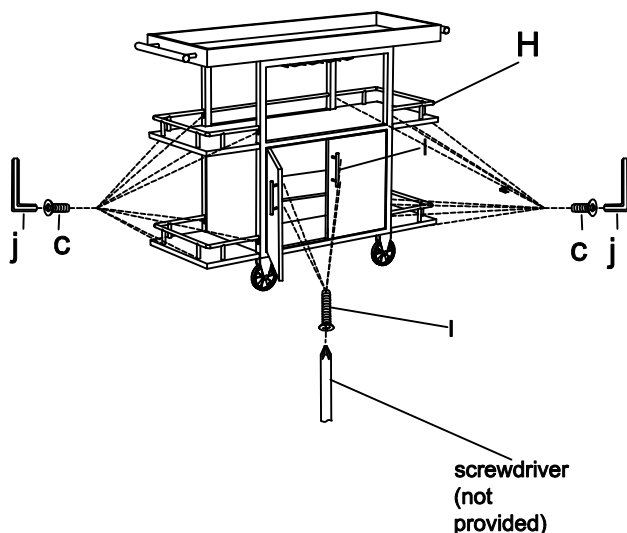
Step 7: Assemble top tray (F) to the assembled base using medium short bolts (d), small flat washers (H), small lock washers (g). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts.



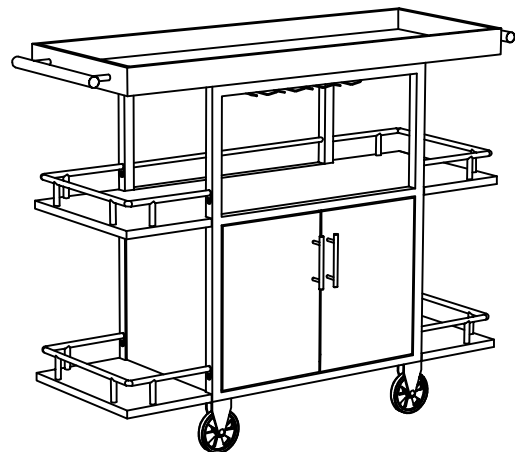
Step 8:

a) Attach metal gallery (H) to the assembled base using bolt (c). Securely tighten all bolts by small Allen wrench (j), but do not over tighten the bolts.

b) Attach the handles (I) to the doors on the front frame (C) using small bolt (I). Securely tighten the screws by a screwdriver (not provided)



Step 9: Securely tighten all bolts by Allen wrench (i or j), but do not over tighten the bolts. Assembly are complete. Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
