




Important safety instructions:

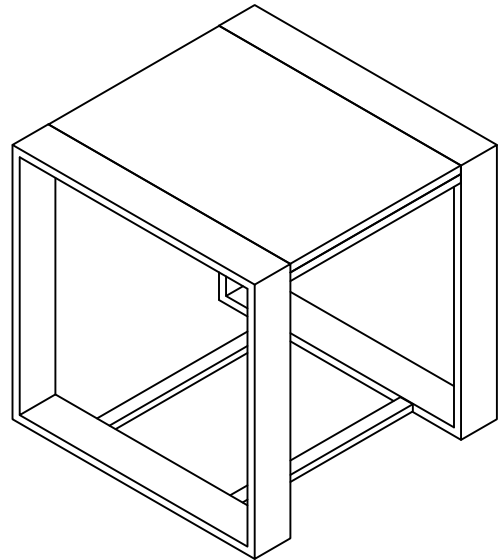
- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the table.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.

Pre-assembly:






- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

Parts List

| Item | Description | QTY |
|------|---|-----|
| P1 | Side Frames  | 2 |
| P2 | Table Top  | 1 |
| P3 | Bottom Stretchers  | 2 |



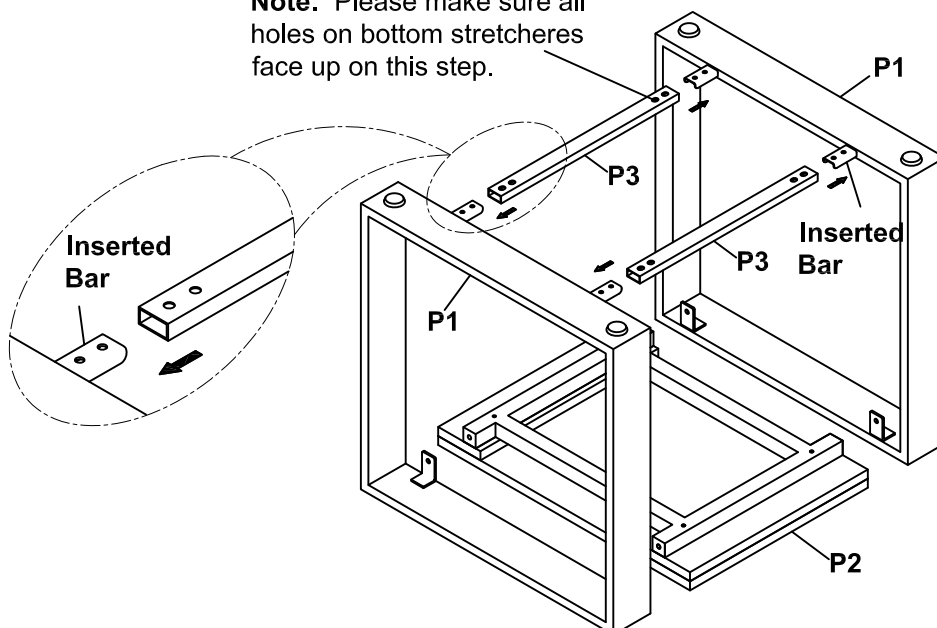
Hardware List

| Item | Description | QTY |
|------|---|-----|
| H1 | Short Bolts Ø1/4"*1/2"L  | 8 |
| H2 | Long Bolts Ø1/4"*1"L  | 4 |
| H3 | Lock Washers  | 12 |
| H4 | Flat Washers  | 12 |
| H5 | Allen Wrench Ø1/4  | 1 |

Assembly Procedures:

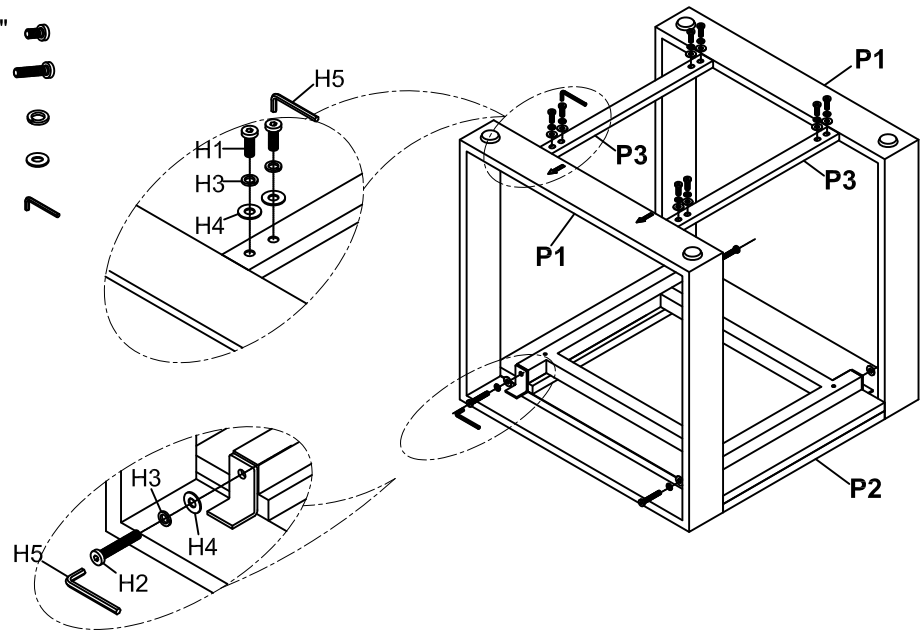
Step 1. Turn over the table top (P2) on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Insert each inserted bar on side frames (P1) to the end of bottom stretchers (P3) as shown below. Do not tighten the bolts at this time.

Note: Please make sure all holes on bottom stretchers face up on this step.



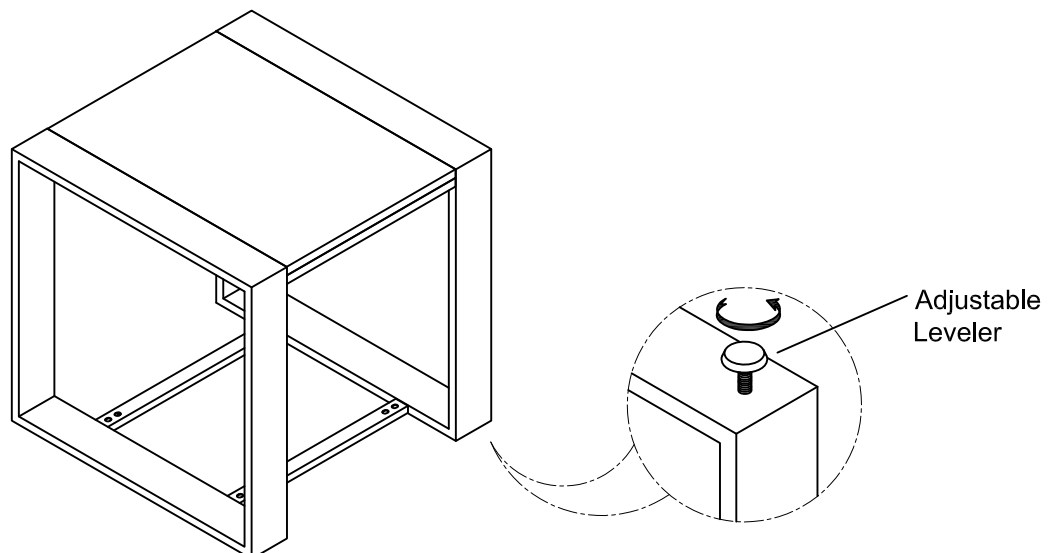
Step 2. Loosely attach side frames (P1) to the table top (P2) and bottom stretchers (P3) using bolts(H1&H2), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4) as shown below.

Step 3.

- 1) Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H5). Turn the assembled table to an upright position.
- 2) **Leveler adjustment:** Levelers are installed on the side frames and adjust as needed to make sure the table is level. Assembly is complete. **Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.**



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
