ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Description: Sterling End Table

Important safety instructions:


- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the table.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.

Pre-assembly:

- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

P1	Table Top	1
P2	Leg Frames	2
P3	Stretcher	1




Hardware List

Item	Description	QTY
H1	Bolts Ø1/4"x3/4"	10
H2	Allen Wrench 1/4"	1

Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach each leg frame (P2) to the bottom of table top (P1) using bolts (H1) as shown below.


(H1)x8 Bolts Ø1/4"x3/4" L
(H2)x1 Allen Wrench 1/4"



Note: Make sure the bar faced inside.


Step 2. Loosely attach the stretcher (P3) to the leg frames (P2) using bolts (H1) as shown below.

(H1)x2 Bolts Ø1/4" x3/4" L



Step 3.

- 1) Securely tighten all the bolts with Allen wrench (H2).
- 2) Then turn the assembled table to an upright position.
- 3) **Leveler adjustment:** Leveler are pre-installed on the legs and adjust as needed to make sure the table is level. Assembly is complete. **Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.**



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
