
Pre-assembly:

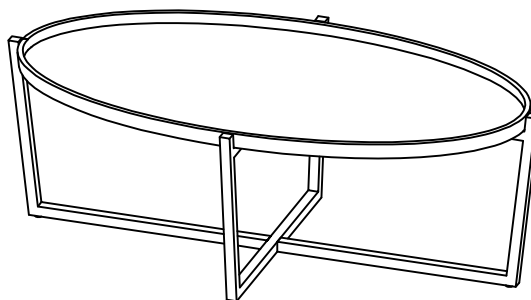
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

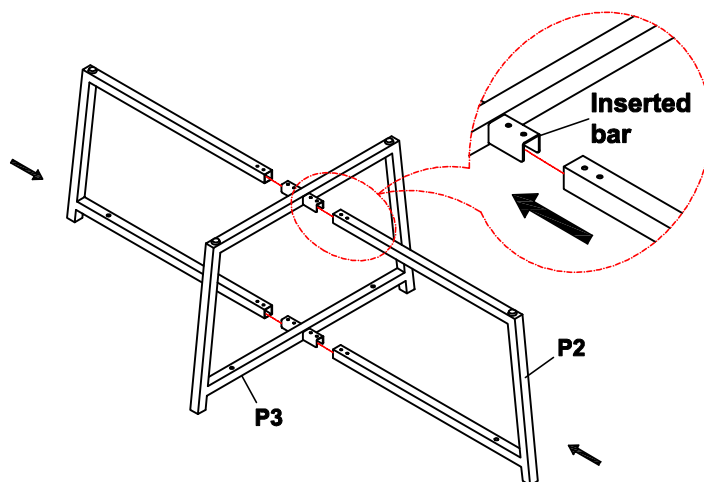

**Assembly Procedures:**

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Insert each inserted bar on middle frame (P3) to the end of side frame (P2), do not tighten the bolts at this time.



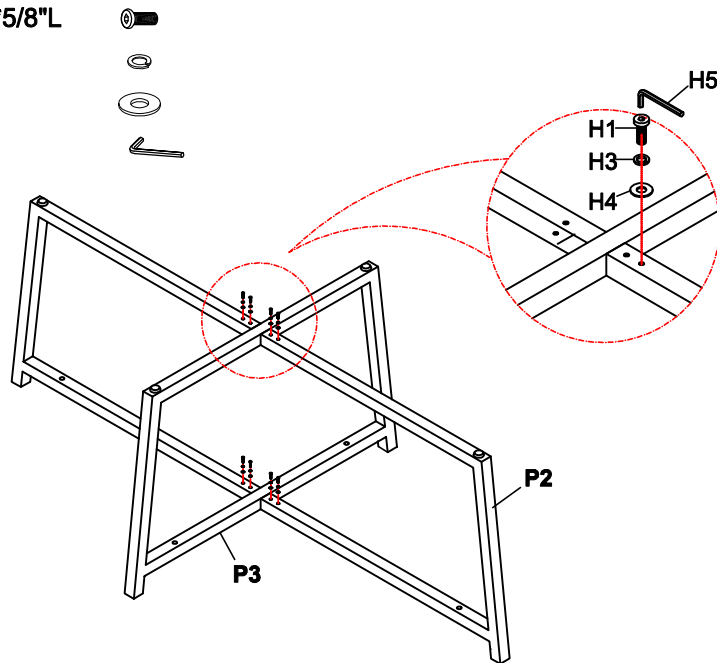
Step 2. Loosely attach side frame (P2) to middle frame (P2) using short Bolts (H1), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4) as shown below.

(H1)x8 Short Bolts $\varnothing 1/4"$ *5/8"L

(H3)x8 Lock Washers

(H4)x8 Flat Washers

(H5)x1 Allen Wrench



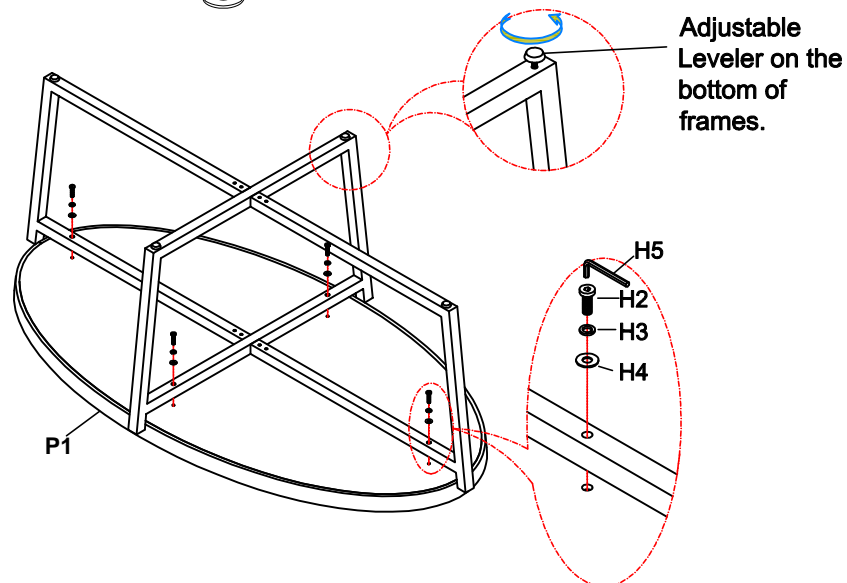
Step 3.

- 1) Loosely attach assembled metal base to the bottom of top panel (P1) using long Bolts (H2), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4) as shown below.
- 2) Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H5). Turn the assembled table to an upright position.
- 3) **Leveler adjustment:** Leveler are installed on the frames and adjust as needed to make sure the table is level. Assembly is complete. **Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.**

(H2)x4 Long Bolts $\varnothing 1/4"$ *1-1/2"L

(H3)x4 Lock Washers

(H4)x4 Flat Washers



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
