





### Important safety instructions:

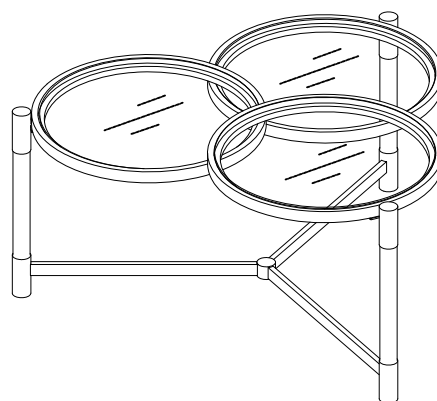
- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling.

- Keep instructions for future use.

### Pre-assembly:




- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

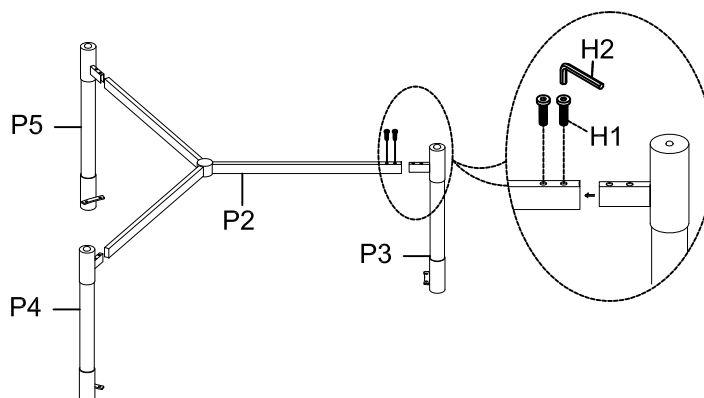
### Hardware List

H1	Bolts Ø1/4"x1/2"		12
H2	Allen Wrench 1/4"		1
H3	Rubber Pad		9

### Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Attach short leg (P3), middle leg(P4) and long leg(P5) to the metal stretcher (P2) as shown on below. Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H2) .

- (H1)x6 Bolts 
- (H2)x1 Allen Wrench 

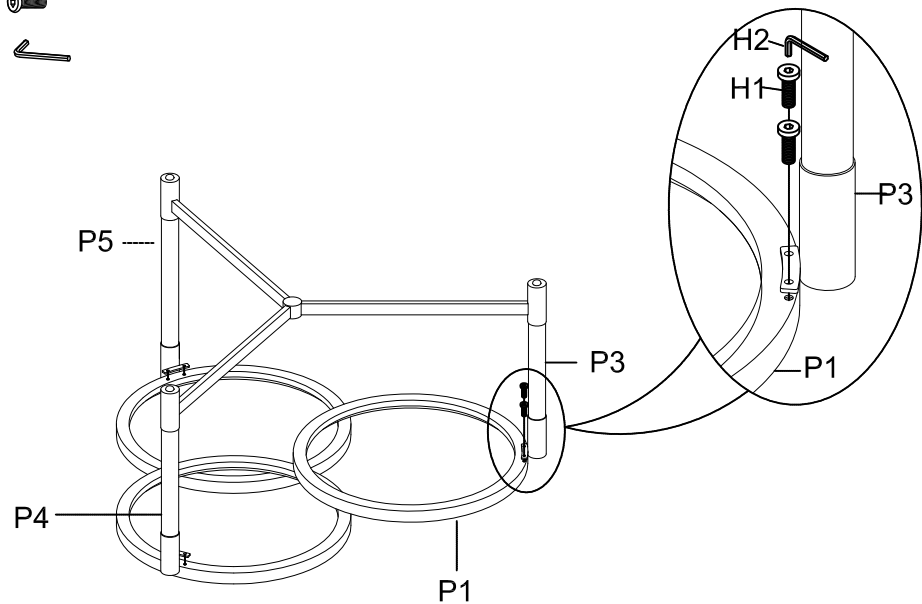


Step 2. Attach the assembled legs (P3,P4,P5) to the metal top frame (P1) as shown on below. Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H2) .

(H2)x1 Allen Wrench

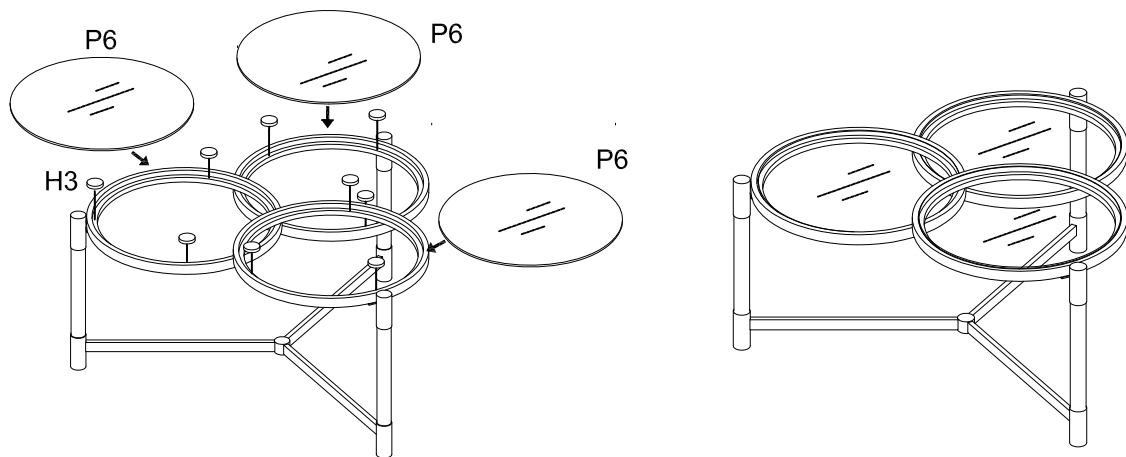


Step 3.

Turn the assembled table to an upright position. Put rubber pad(H3) on the top frame (P1) as shown below, then gently lay the glass (P6) on the pad. Assembly is complete.

Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.
