**Pre-assembly:**

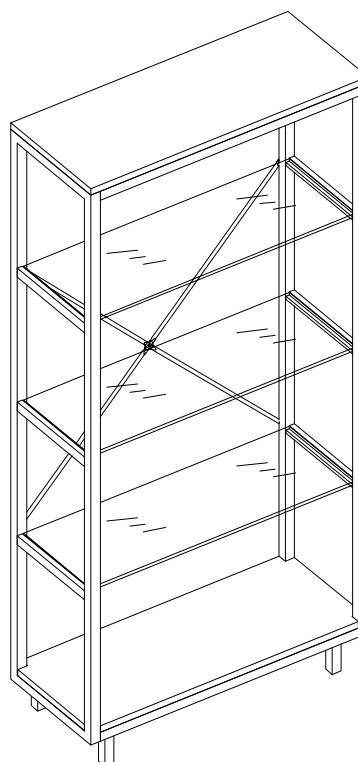
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

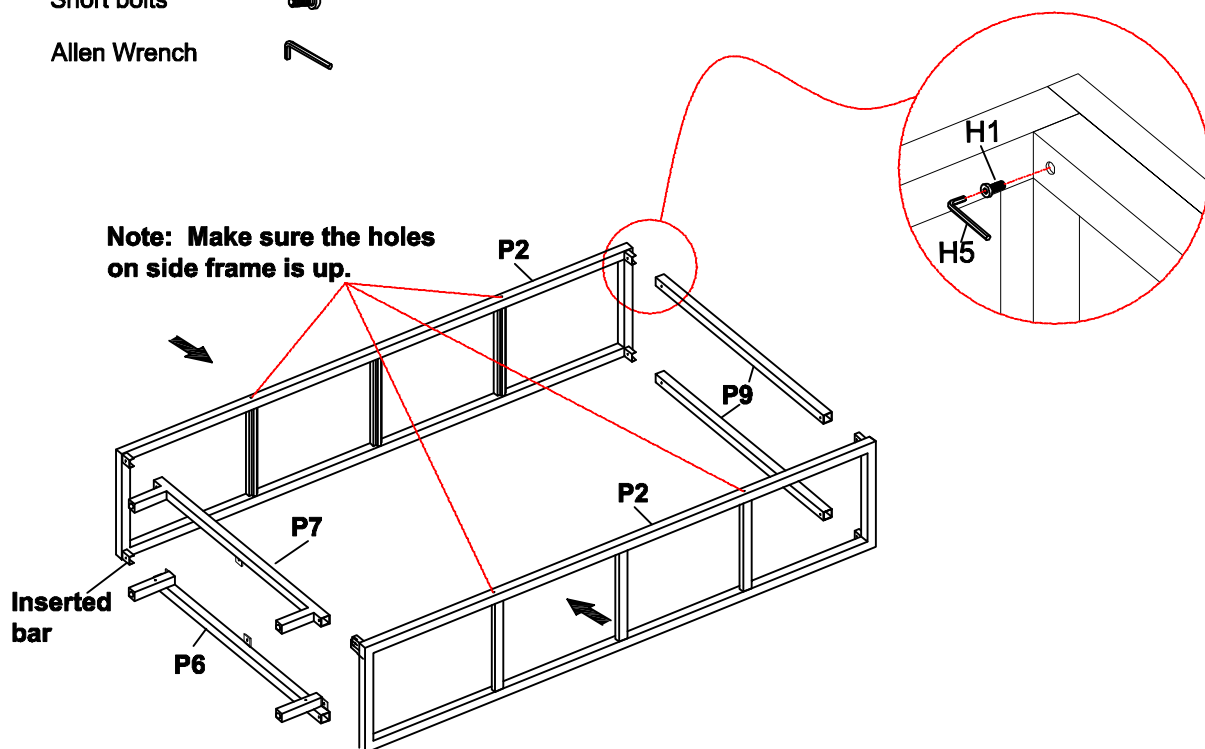

### Assembly Procedures:

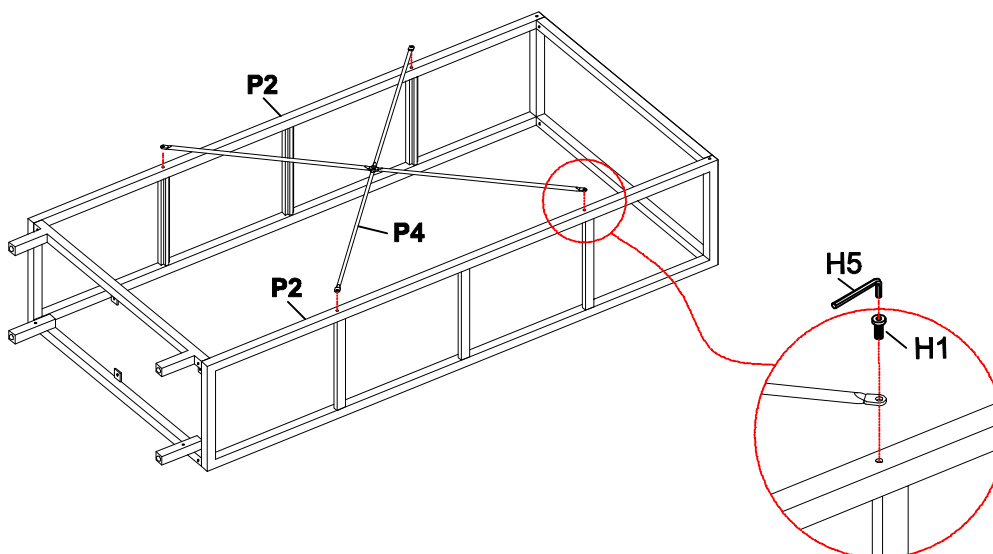
**Step 1.** Assemble the bookcase on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Insert each inserted bar on side frames (P2) to the end of top rails (P9) and front/back leg frame (P6 & P7) as shown below. Loosely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H5).

- (H1)x4    Short bolts    
- (H5)x1    Allen Wrench    



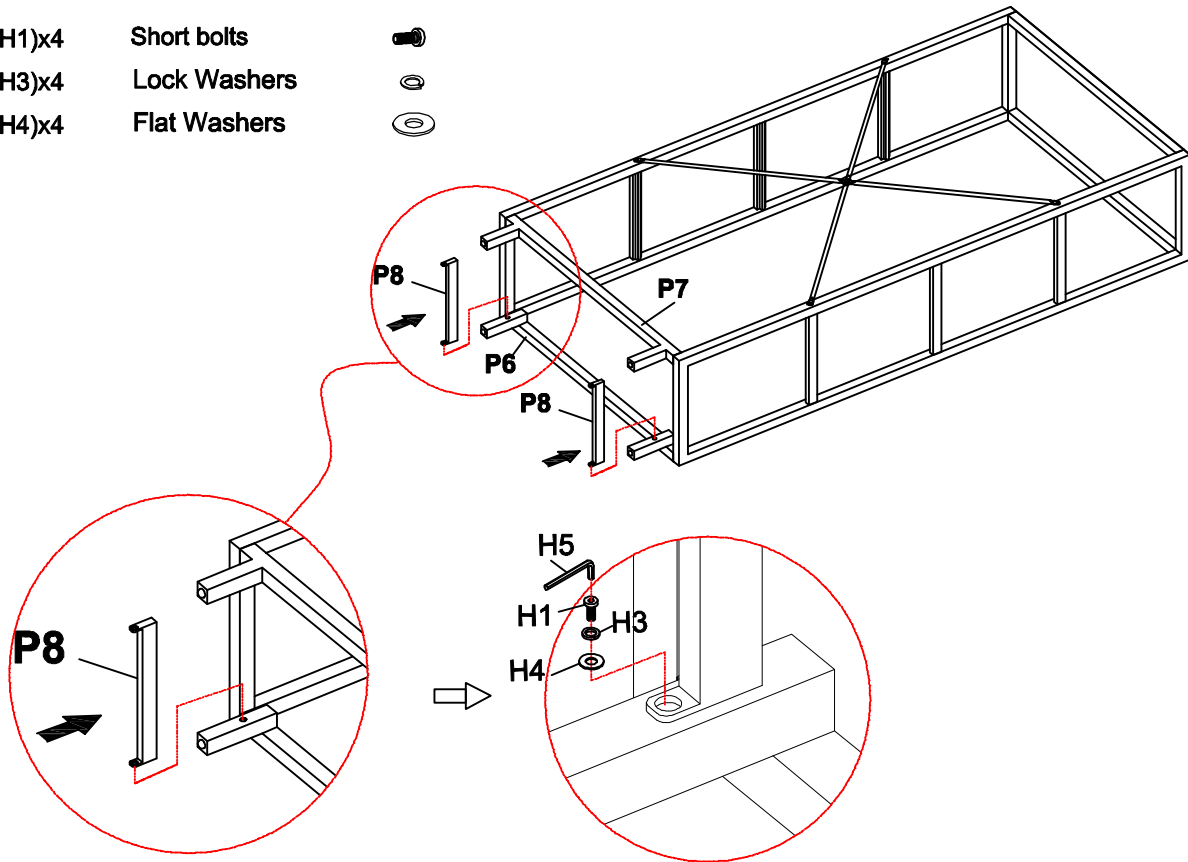
**Step 2.** Loosely attach "X" crossing rail (P4) to the holes on the back of side frame (P2) using bolts (H1) as shown below.

- (H1)x4    Short bolts    



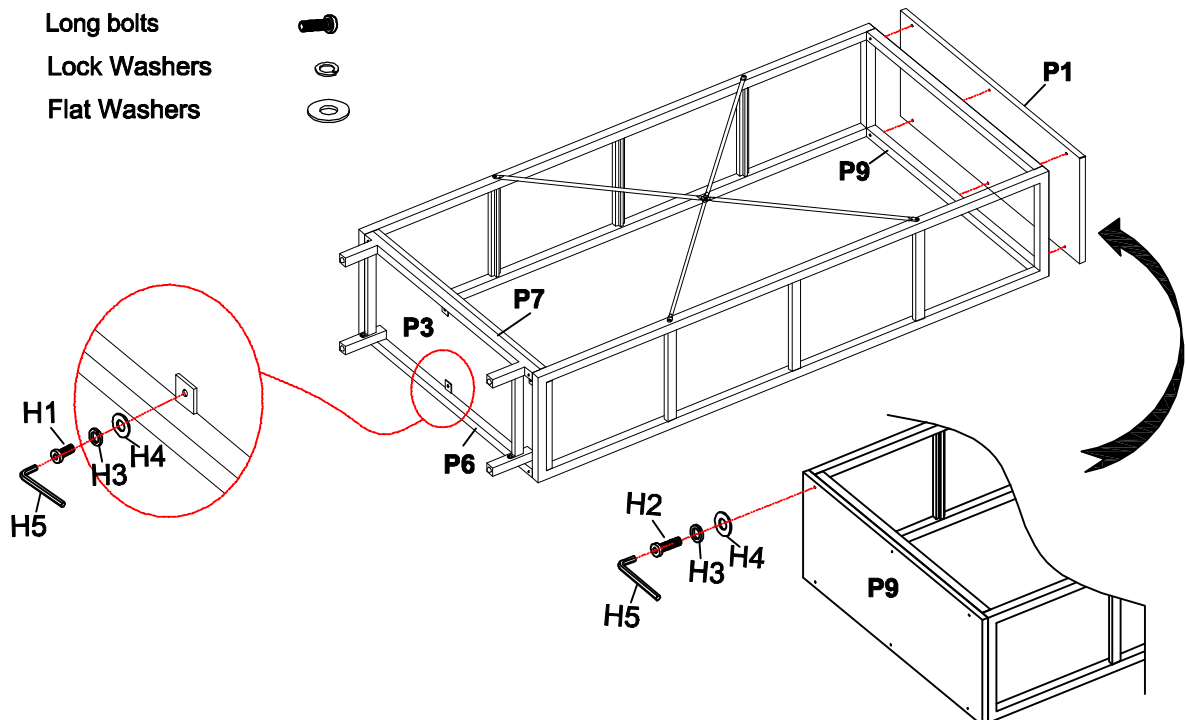
**Step 3.** Attach side bottom rails (P8) to assembled front/back leg frame (P6&P7) using bolts (H1), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4) as shown below.

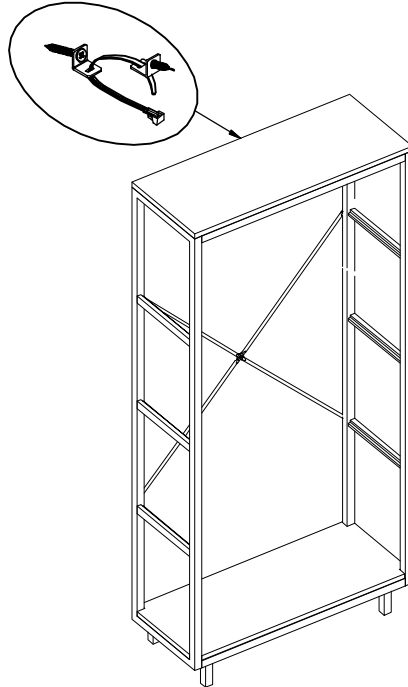
**Step 4.** Attach top panel (P1) and bottom shelf (P3) to the assembled front/back leg frame (P6 & P7) and top rails (P9) using bolts (H1&H2), lock washers (H3) and flat washers (H4) as shown below.

#### Step 5.

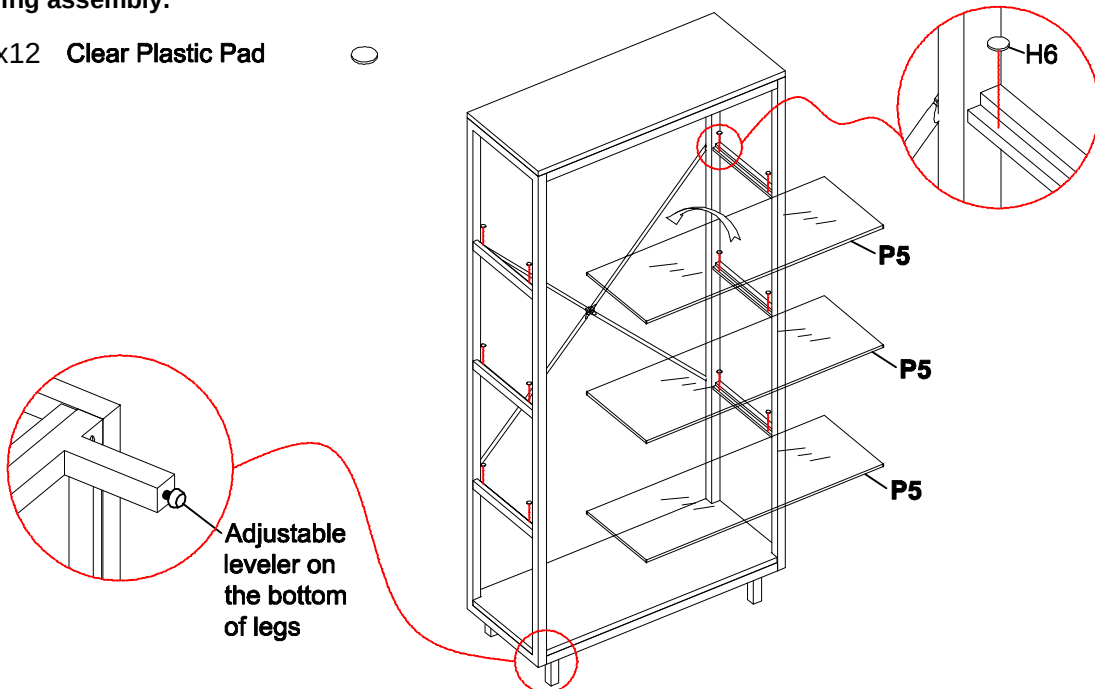
- 1) Turn the assembled bookcase to an upright position. Make sure the bookcase is level and then securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H4).
- 2) **Recommend that you attach the products to your wall as a safety precaution.** Please see the other instructions "Furniture Safety Bracket Tip Resistant".



#### Step 6.

- 1) Place the clear plastic pad (H6) on the assembled bookcase as shown below.
- 2) Gently lay the glass shelves (P5) on the assembled frame of bookcase.
- 3) **Leveler adjustment:** Leveler are installed on the legs and adjust as needed to make sure the table is level. Assembly is complete. **Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.**

# Furniture Safety Bracket Tip Resistant

- Designed to help prevent furniture tipover.
- Detachable strap allows for easy moving of furniture for cleaning.
- Also helps prevent furniture tipover during minor tremore.

## Installation:

### Bolt (1pc)



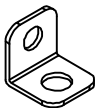
### Long Screw (1pc)



### Strap (1pc)



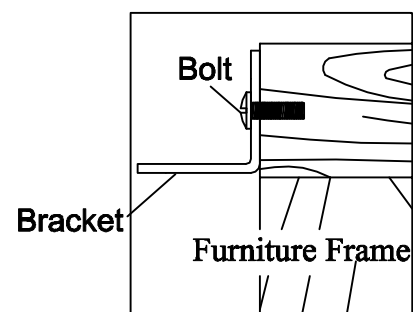
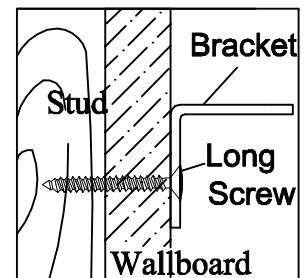
### Bracket (2pcs)



1. Locate a wall stud behind your furniture. Position a bracket on the stud approximately 1" below the top frame of the furniture. Mark and drill pilot hole into the center of the stud with a 3/32" drill bit. Attach a bracket to the stud with the long screws provided. Making sure the metal bracket extend UPWARD as shown.

2. On the back of the furniture. Attach the metal bracket to the back of top frame with bolt, making sure the metal bracket extend DOWNWARD as shown.

3. Move the furniture into its final position, taking care to line up the wall bracket with the furniture bracket. Thread a strap through the bracket as shown in the illustration. Tighten strap until snug. Do not over tighten.



## Important:

Check to be sure the wall bracket is firmly screwed into wall stud, the furniture bracket is firmly attached to the frame, and the strap is snug.
