

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Description: Porter Console Table

Important safety instructions:


- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling the table.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.

Pre-assembly:

- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

B	Short Posts	4
C	Shelf Frame	1
D	Long Posts	4
E	"X" stretcher	1
F	Feet	4
G	Top Glass	1
H	Shelf Glass	1





b	Clear Plastic Pad	20

Assembly Procedures:


Step 1. Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish.

- 1) Screw each bolt (a) into the holes of top frame (A).
- 2) Attach each short post (B) to the bottom of top frame (A) following the label "TOP" on the top of post as shown below. Securely tighten the short posts (B).


(a)x4 Bolts Ø1/4*2-3/8"



Step 2. Attach long post (D) to short post (B) through shelf frame(C) as shown below. Securely tighten the long posts (D).



Step 3. Attach feet (D) to the lower post (D) through "X" stretcher (E) as shown below. Securely tighten the feet (F).




Step 4.

- 1) Turn the assembled table to an upright position.
- 2) Place the clear plastic pad (b) on the top frame (A) and shelf frame (C) as shown below.
- 3) Gently lay the top glass (G) and shelf glass (H) on the top frame (A) and shelf frame (C) as shown below.

Assembly is complete.

ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
