

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Description: Boyd Console Table







### Important safety instructions:

- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.




### Pre-assembly:

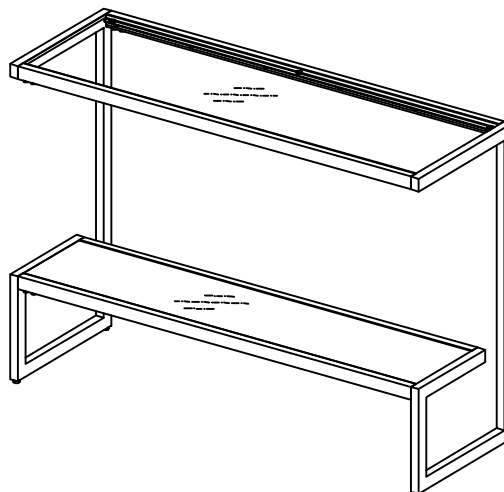
- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

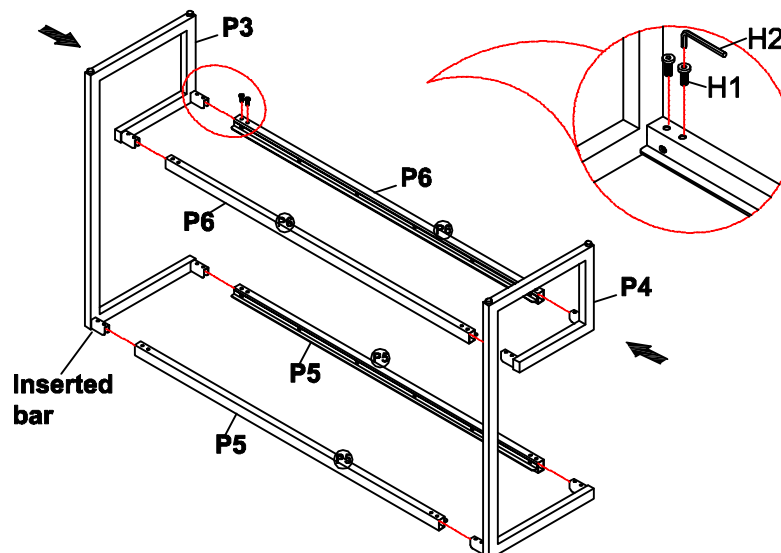

### Assembly Procedures:

**Step 1.** Assemble the table on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish. Insert each inserted bar on side frames (P3, P4) to the end of top rails (P5) and bottom rails (P6) **following the labels "P5" on top rails (P5) and the labels "P6" on bottom rails (P6) accordingly as shown below.** Loosely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H2).

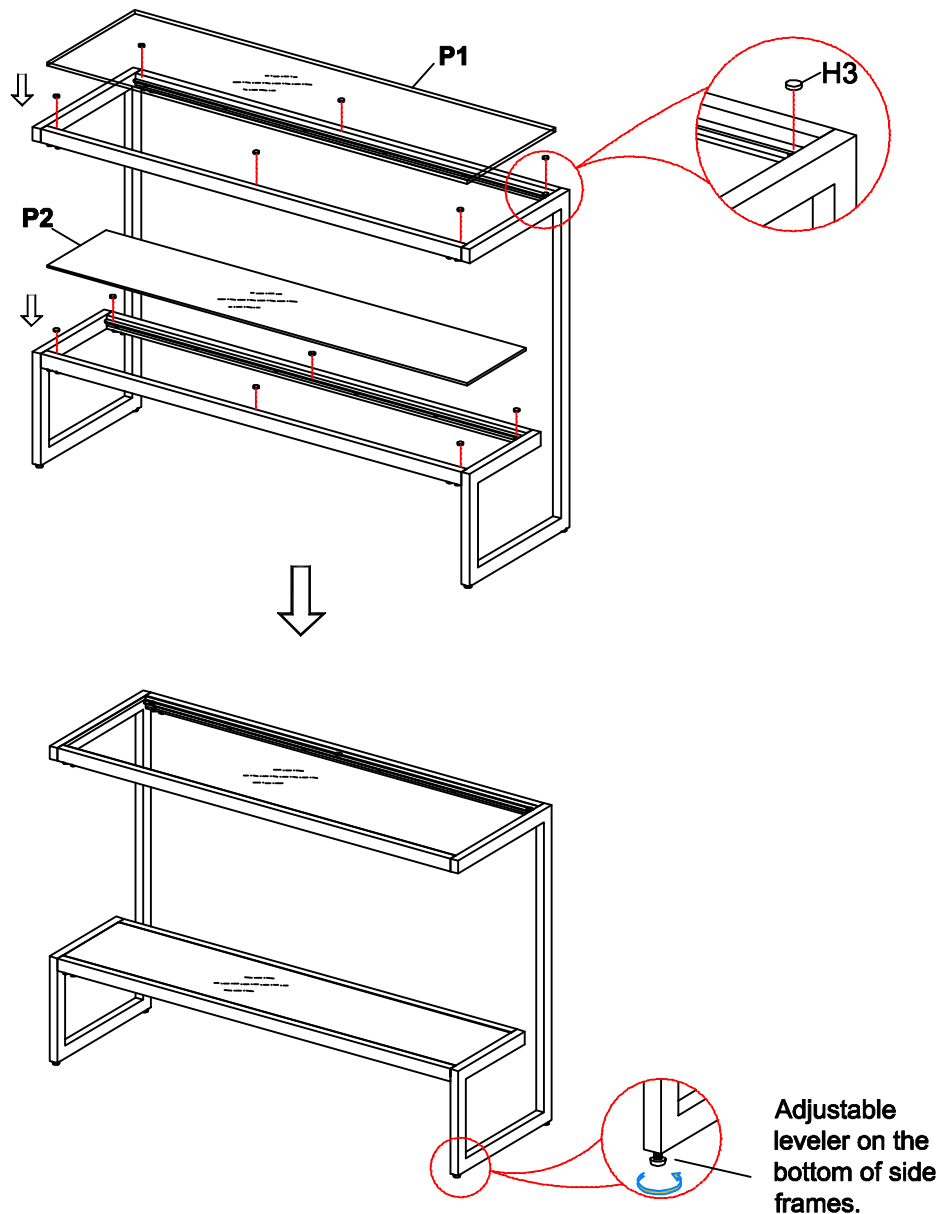
- (H1)x16 bolts 
- (H2)x1 Allen Wrench 



### Step 2.

- 1) Turn the assembled table to an upright position. Make sure the table top frame and the shelf frame are even, and then securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H2).
- 2) Place the clear plastic pad (H3) on the assembled table as shown below.
- 3) Gently lay the glass top (P1) and mirror shelf (P2) on the assembled table.
- 4) **Leveler adjustment:** Levelers are installed on the legs and adjust as needed to make sure the table is level. Assembly is complete.

**Caution:** Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.

ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
