Description: Caleb Bar Cart





Important safety instructions:

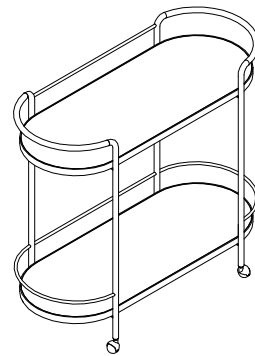
- Please carefully read all instructions before assembling.
- For your safety and ease, assembly by two or more adults is recommended.
- Keep instructions for future use.

Pre-assembly:





- Do not discard any contents until after assembly is complete to avoid accidentally discarding small parts or hardware.
- Remove all parts and hardware from box along with any plastic protective packaging.

Parts List

| Item | Description | | QTY |
|------|------------------|---|-----|
| P1 | Shelves |  | 2 |
| P2 | Left Side Frame |  | 1 |
| P3 | Right Side Frame |  | 1 |
| P4 | Stretchers |  | 2 |



Hardware List

| Item | Description | | QTY |
|------|---------------------------------|---|-----|
| H1 | Bolts $\phi 1/4" \times 5/8" L$ |  | 8 |
| H2 | Lock Washers 1/4" |  | 8 |
| H3 | Flat Washers 1/4" |  | 8 |
| H4 | Allen Wrench 1/4" |  | 1 |

Assembly Procedures:

Step 1. Assemble the bar cart on a flat, soft surface such as a carpet or cloth to prevent scratching the finish.
With one person to help, attach the shelves (P1) to one left side frames(P2) as shown below image 1.





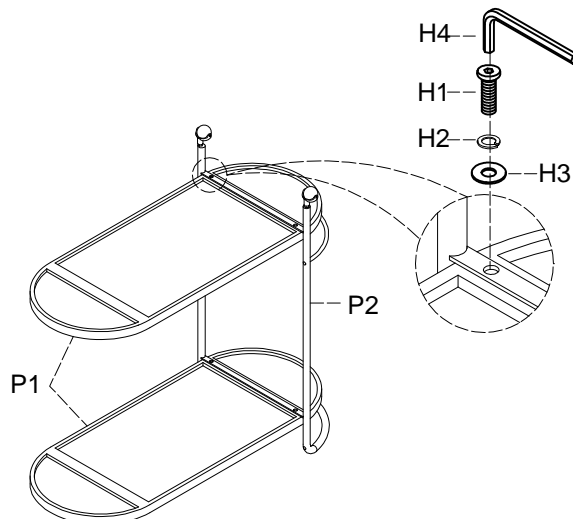
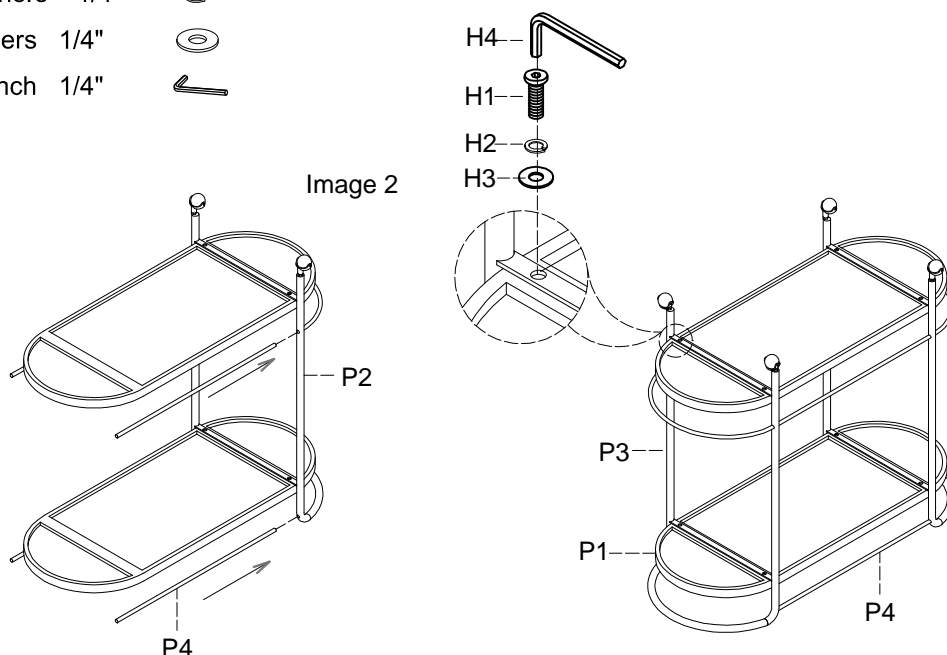
- (H1)x4 Bolts $\phi 1/4" \times 5/8" L$ 
- (H2)x4 Lock Washers 1/4" 
- (H3)x4 Flat Washers 1/4" 
- (H4)x1 Allen Wrench 1/4"

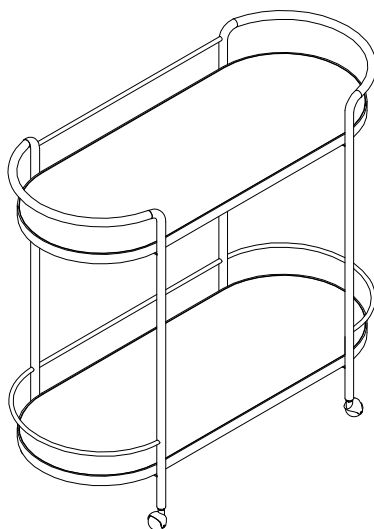
Step 2. Insert the stretchers (P4) to the assembled left side frame (P2), then attach the right side frame (P3) to the shelves (P1) as shown below image 2.

| (H2)x4 | Lock Washers 1/4" |  |
| (H3)x4 | Flat Washers 1/4" |  |
| (H4)x1 | Allen Wrench 1/4" |  |



Step 3.

- Securely tighten all bolts with Allen wrench (H4).
- Turn the assembled bar cart to an upright position. Assembly is complete.
- Failure to follow these instructions may cause the bolts to misalign during assembly.



ADDITIONAL NOTE ABOUT SAFETY: BOLTS MAY LOOSEN DURING NORMAL EVERYDAY USE. THEY SHOULD BE PERIODICALLY INSPECTED AND RE-TIGHTENED TO PREVENT DAMAGE OR INJURY. ALWAYS CHECK TO BE SURE THAT ALL HARDWARE IS KEPT TIGHTENED.
